April will post pictures in the WAAG.</li> <li>PAC friendship bench has been reinstalled by the back garden area with a Dogwood Tree (tree paid for by the school).</li> <li>District perspective - all families will receive a survey asking for feedback on this year (regarding covid, transitional learning etc). The survey will include your experience ar your child's experience.</li> <li>Supervised lunches - we have noticed children are eating more and finishing their lunches. Fewer conflicts are happening as well.</li> <li>Regarding the two 30 min breaks - longer stretches outside and children have been benefiting from extra outdoor times.</li> <li>Hand sanitizing/ washing etc - way less illness in the school happening this year.</li> <li>Outdoor space - mud kitchen. Paid for by a grant. The purpose is to inspire creative play outdoors. Students who don't normally play on the playground are learning and playing more.</li> <li>March 10 board meeting deciding on whether to extend transitional learning. A very small Gilmore group learning online currently.</li> <li>Grade 7 Grad book continues.</li> <li>Pizza - Admin has checked what the process is with other schools doing hot lunches.</li> <li>Sports equipment isn't being allowed outside currently.</li> </ul>
