Admin Report:

- With recent Covid updates we are waiting on more updates regarding covid restrictions being lifted. We may slowly be easing on grouping indoors together. Updates to come as the school district operates a little differently vs provincial orders.

- Morning announcements. Students will be going to classes to do them. Students are still planning this out and preparing.
