- Taking one thing at a time, September is a busy month and some hiring still happening
- Roofing project hopefully finished mid-October
- Flooring replaced throughout school

- Affordability fund announced from school district and logistics tbd: pays for school supplies, hot lunch, field trips...to support families in need
- Accessibility to the building-how to reopen and invite parents and students into the school again post-covid. Liability, security, union and admin issues to be worked out. Hoping there will be consistent language surrounding this for all schools in Richmond. This is a 'work in progress' in the district.
