IMPORTANT: Appropriate Costumes for Halloween:

Please talk with your children about appropriate costumes for Halloween as we need to be aware that celebrating Halloween needs to be fun for ALL. Halloween offers an opportunity to have meaningful conversations about costume choices with our community and requires consideration. In doing so, it is important to keep in mind that we need to be sensitive to groups that have been marginalized through mimicry and cultural appropriation during Halloween and other 'dress up' events. A few things to keep in mind is that the following are NOT Costumes: RACE (black face/brown face) CULTURE (Indigenous regalia/dreadlocks) RELIGIOUS FAITH (religious figures/gods/saints/gurus/hijab) GENDER (gender switching for humour or to mock) TRAUMA (hangman's noose/weapons). Please ensure that you remind your children that there will be NO Weapons. Thank you.
