Admin Report: Trevor Shuto, Principal

- Student reports will be published Dec 14th through 'my parent portal'
- Clothing donations: we have a lot of outdoor clothing for primary kids, we can use intermediate sizes and Trevor has responded directly to parents who are offering
- Winter Wonderland Skating, Dec 14th (Wed) via school buses likely in 2 batches
- Opportunity to apply for another Outdoor Learning Space Innovation Grant through the district to build a few more around the school grounds-stay tuned! (however Maintenance department is overbooked so we're in a long queue)
- Staff has also applied for specific grants for school club funding, seating/classroom variations for students with accommodation/modification needs
- Question about ventilation in the school: phase 1 of installing air ventilation in the school but unknown timeline and ventilation units are not small, so lots of things to be worked out. Hopefully starting in 2023!
- Question about rodent sightings lately in classrooms—regular pest control protocol is determined by the district
- Saleema Noon Body Science: usually every 2 years, so we'll go back to it in 2023
- Question about Holiday Concert: there's going to be something but TBD!
- Question about sock gathering for Covenant House (something done in the past)
- Question about Holiday Wish donations–Trevor is working with a local church who will likely be able to support the whole program with PAC possibly donating grocery cards

## Chair Report: Laurel

- Outdoor Ed: PAC has \$2500 budgeted but will need \$4000 to cover \$50/child (we have approx 81 kids for all 6's and 7's)
  -looking at \$350+ per kid including buses and camp and student affordability fund will cover some of the kids
  -idea of having a specific bottle drive in the New Year for Outdoor Ed
  -idea of having a tiered payment plan: pay what you can, 50%, 70%, 100%...
- Reminder to teachers/resource teachers/EA's to spend their PAC teacher allotments
