- 3. Hot Lunch Absences If you have ordered hot lunch and your child(ren) is away that day we will keep the hot lunch in the fridge for a day for you to pick it up.
- 4. Affordability Fund Reminder The Student and Family Affordability Fund is still in place if you require financial assistance with school-related costs such as school and course fees, workbooks, specialty supplies, field trips and other school-related charges and costs. Please reach out to Mr. Shuto if you could benefit from this fund.

5. Feeding Futures - The provincial government announced a new Feeding Futures School Program Fund, designed to help with nutritional supports for students. We are working closely with a District Staff Member and we want to ensure families are aware to reach out to Mr. Shuto if you require support. Requests will be treated with dignity and your privacy will be respected.
